The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality and Enterprise Gas Processing, LLC, Agency Interest Numbers 4762, 51546 and 43501 have entered into a proposed settlement agreement, Settlement Tracking No. SA-AE-14-0001, concerning the State's allegations of environmental violations by Respondent at its facility in St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, which allegations are set forth in Consolidated Compliance Order & Notice of Potential Penalty, LDEQ Enforcement Numbers AE-PP-08-0214, AE-PP-10-00699 and AE-PP-11-00405 and other violations the Respondent requested the Department of Environmental Quality to include in the settlement and which are not in the Consolidated Compliance Order & Notice of Potential Penalty.

St. Charles Parish does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission to, access to, or operations of programs, services or activities.

St. Charles Parish does not discriminate on the basis of disability in its hiring or employment practices. The Parish will not ask a job applicant about the existence nature or severity of a disability. Applicants may be asked about their ability to perform specific job functions. The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on a draft Louisiana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) permit prepared for Archer Daniels Midland Co., Midstream Loading Operations, P.O. Box 656, Ama, LA 70031. The facility is located operating between River Miles 1.5 and 237 on the Mississippi River, Mississippi River Gulf Outlet, and other connecting commercial water transportation accesses along the Mississippi River in Plaquemines, St. Bernard, Orleans, Jefferson, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist, St. James, Iberville, Ascension, East Baton Rouge and West Baton Rouge Parishes; at Port Manchac on the Intracoastal Waterway in Tangipahoa Parishes; at the Port of Baton Rouge, River Miles 228.5 and 229.5 on the Intracoastal Waterway in West Baton Rouge Parishes; and at the Port Lake Charles on the Intracoastal Waterway and other connecting commercial water transportation accesses in Calcasieu Parish. Upon the effective date of the final permit, the LPDES permit shall replace the previously issued LPDES permit.

The principal discharge from this existing source is made into the Mississippi River, Mississippi River Gulf Outlet and other connecting commercial water transportation accesses along the Mississippi River; Port Manchac on the Port of Baton Rouge, River Miles 228.5 and 229.5 on the Intracoastal Waterway; and the Port of Lake Charles on the Intracoastal Waterway and other connecting commercial water transportation accesses in Tangipahoa Parishes; at the Port of Baton Rouge, River Miles 228.5 and 229.5 on the Intracoastal Waterway in West Baton Rouge Parishes; and at the Port Lake Charles on the Intracoastal Waterway and other connecting commercial water transportation accesses in Calcasieu Parish. Under the SIC Code 4491, the applicant proposes to discharge maintenance ballast and void water, equipment/deck washdown water, and treated sanitary wastewater from derrick crane midstream loading operations.

During the preparation of this permit, it has been determined that the discharge will have no adverse impact on the existing uses of the receiving waterbody. As with any discharge, however, some change in existing water quality may occur.
