NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of Hospital Service District No. 1 of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "District"), or his designee, will hold a public hearing on behalf of the Issuer on Monday, July 28, 2014, at ten o'clock (10:00) a.m. at St. Charles Parish Hospital (the "Hospital"), Administration Suite 2200, Magnolia Room, 1057 Paul Maillard Road, Luling, Louisiana 70070, with respect to the reissuance of the District's indebtedness as qualified 501(c)(3) bonds under the applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Title to the Hospital is in the public. The Hospital is entering into an agreement with St. Charles Operational Management Company LLC ("SCMC"), a Louisiana limited liability company and subsidiary of Ochsner Health System, a 501(c)(3) corporation. The reissuance will apply to the following indebtedness issued by the District: (i) \$7,500,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2005 (the "Series 2005 Bonds"); (ii) \$5,700,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2006 (the "Series 2006 Bonds"); (iii) \$5,500,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2007 (the "Series 2007 Bonds"); (iv) \$5,500,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2009 (the "Series 2009 Bonds"); (v) \$1,000,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2009A (the "Series 2009A Bonds"); (vi) \$8,000,000 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2012A (the "Series 2012A Bonds"); and (vii) \$4,350,000 General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2013A (the "Series 2013A Bonds") and together with the Series 2005 Bonds, Series 2006 Bonds, Series 2007 Bonds, Series 2009 Bonds, Series 2009A Bonds, and Series 2012A Bonds, the "Bonds").

The Series 2005 Bonds, Series 2006 Bonds and Series 2007 Bonds were issued for construction of the Hospital's Vial Patient Care Center (the "Center"). The Series 2009 Bonds were issued for the Hospital's East Bank EMS substation (the "Substation") and renovations to the Hospital's emergency department. The Series 2009A Bonds were issued for renovation's to the Hospital's cafeteria and the purchase of two ambulances. The Series 2012A Bonds were issued for the construction of the cardiac catheterization laboratory, renovations to the catheterization offices and physician recruitment at the Hospital. The Series 2013A Bonds refunded previous indebtedness of the District that was issued to construct the first floor of the Hospital's West Bank Medical Office Building, a surgery department addition, and construction of the Center. With the exception of the Substation located at 13616 River Road, Destrehan, LA 70047, all facilities are located at 1057 Paul Maillard Road, Luling, Louisiana 70070.

The initial and exclusive owner, operator and manager of the foregoing facilities is the District, which, through its public operating subsidiary St. Charles Parish Hospital Corporation, expects to enter into a special services management and operations agreement with SCMC.

The Secretary of the District, or his designee, shall conduct the public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments on and hearing any objections (verbal or written) to the proposed reissuance of the Bonds. All interested parties are invited to attend such public hearing to express their views. #### REMOVAL OF WEEDS, GRASS & OTHER NOXIOUS MATTER

If the following violations are not rectified within (5) days of this published notice, the parish will proceed in bringing the properties listed in compliance with Chapter 16, Article III Sec. 16-24 through Sec. 16-28, (as amended). The fee for performing these services shall be at a rate of 0.035 per square foot of the lot cleaned. The contractor's fee for performing these services shall be at the rate of .028 per square foot of the lot cleaned. In the event a mini-clean up is required prior to performing the above services, a fee of \$55.39 per mini clean up plus actual disposal fees will be assessed, not to exceed then (10) mini-cleanups per property in violation. On property where trash and/or debris accumulation is such that it requires heavy equipment, bulldozer, front-end loaders, etc. a fee of forty one dollars and five cents (\$41.05) per cubic yard will be assessed.
