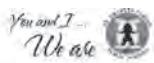

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Article IV, Section 21(D)(1) of the Louisiana Constitution, that on September 1, 2015, Entergy Louisiana, LLC ("ELL") and Entergy Gulf States Louisiana, L.L.C. ("EGSL"), public utilities providing retail electric and gas service throughout the State of Louisiana, jointly filed with the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("LPSC") their Formula Rate Plan Rider Schedule FRP Evaluation Report and Worksheets for Test Year 2014 on a combined-company basis consistent with the implementation of rates following the closing of the Business Combination transaction that is the subject of LPSC Docket No. U-33244. The Business Combination transaction was approved on August 26, 2015. On September 14, 2015, the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("LPSC") issued Order No. U-33244-A formally approving the business combination of Entergy Gulf States Louisiana, L.L.C. ("Old EGSL") and Entergy Louisiana, LLC ("Old ELL"), through which Old EGSL and Old ELL requested to combine substantially all of their respective assets and liabilities into a single operating company, Entergy Louisiana, LLC ("New ELL"). On October 1, 2015 (the "Effective Date") the business combination was consummated. The September 1, 2015, filing was updated on November 19, 2015, to incorporate the non-fuel effects of flowing through Guaranteed Customer Credits as required by LPSC Order No. U-33244-A. The filing reflects the resulting FRP factors to be applied to each of New ELL's rate classes (except those excluded under ELL Rider Schedule FRP) effective for customer bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of December 2015.

The proposed adjustment in rates will have the following estimated effects on applicable Legacy ELL customers' typical monthly bills (based on the Fuel Adjustment Clause and Environmental Adjustment Clause factors for the month of October 2015): a typical monthly bill for a Residential customer using 1,000 kWh would decrease approximately \$2.31, from \$101.55 to \$99.24; a typical monthly bill for a Small General Service customer using 50 kW and 12,500 kWh would decrease approximately \$34.69, from \$1,442.24 to \$1,407.55; a typical monthly bill for a Large General Service customer using 1,000 kW and 500,000 kWh would decrease approximately \$771.91, from \$39,249.85 to \$38,477.94.

The proposed adjustment in rates will have the following estimated effects on applicable Legacy EGSL customers' typical monthly bills: a typical monthly bill for a Residential customer using 1,000 kWh would decrease approximately \$0.47, from \$122.02 to \$121.55; a typical monthly bill for a Small General Service customer using 5000 kWh would decrease approximately \$2.66 from \$698.25 to \$695.59; a typical monthly bill for a Large General Service customer using 500 kW and 255,500 kWh would decrease approximately \$80.00, from \$25,328.25 to \$25,248.25.
