The facility is located at 7420 River Road, Montz, St. Charles Parish.  
 Enterigy Louisiana, LLC (ELL), a subsidiary of the New Orleans based Entergy Corporation, requested authorization to construct and operate the St. Charles Power Station (SCPS) in Montz, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana. The SCPS will be located within the boundary of the property on which ELL's existing Little Gypsy Generating Plant is located. The SCPS will consist of a combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT) unit which will consist of two (2) natural gas-fired gas turbines, each with a heat recovery steam generator unit equipped with duct burners, and one steam generator turbine. The SCPS will have a predicted net nominal output of 980 megawatts (MW) at international standards organization (ISO) conditions with supplemental duct firing. Ancillary equipment associated with the SCPS will include a cooling tower, a 2,584 horsepower (HP) emergency diesel generator, a 282 HP diesel-fired fire water pump, and a 30,000 gallon pressurized aqueous ammonia (19%) storage tank.  
 This permit was processed as an expedited permit in accordance with LAC 33:III Chapter 18.

The St. Charles Power Station (SCPS) will be a major source of toxic air pollutants (TAPs) pursuant to LAC 33:III Chapter 51; however, pursuant to LAC 33:III 5105.B.2, electric utility steam-generating units (EGUs) are not regulated under Subchapter A of LAC 33:III Chapter 51. In addition, emissions from the combustion of Group 1 virgin fossil fuels (i.e., natural gas) are exempt from the requirements of Subchapter A per LAC 33:III 5105.B.3.A. After removing the TAPs emitted from the EGUs from the facility's overall TAPs emission rates, the SCPS will be classified as a minor source of LAC 33:III Chapter 51 TAPs.  
 The SCPS will be a major source under the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program, LAC 33:III 509. The proposed facility will result in significant net emissions increases of PM<sub>10</sub>, PM<sub>2.5</sub>, NO<sub>x</sub>, CO, VOC, H<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>, HMT, and CO<sub>2</sub>; therefore, PSD requirements, including best available control technology (BACT), apply for these pollutants. The selection of BACT was based on a "top down" approach; a more thorough discussion of the BACT selection process can be found in proposed permit PSD-LA-864.  
 Neither the project nor the general commercial, residential, industrial, or other growth associated with it is expected to have a significant adverse impact on soil, vegetation, visibility, or air quality in the area of the facility or any Class I area. Modeling of PM<sub>10</sub>, PM<sub>2.5</sub> (annual), NO<sub>x</sub>, and CO emissions from the proposed project indicates that the maximum off-site ground level concentrations of these pollutants will be below their respective PSD ambient significance levels and preconstruction monitoring levels. 
