Kati Ward lost her home in Hurricane Ida, and yet she feels more connected to her sense of home than ever.

"This community brought us back to life when we felt like we couldn't go on another second," Ward said.

Ward, her husband Josh and their two children were displaced in August after Ida ripped the roof off of their Hahnville home, the lasting result of a frightening night in

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Deadline set for debris collection

As cleanup efforts continue around St. Charles Parish, officials recently announced Dec. 5 will serve as the deadline for all residents to put debris out for collection.

Debris collection will end on that date, and St. Charles Parish communications director Samantha de Castro said residents should put their debris out curbside by that date to ensure it is picked up. She added that, to date, the

parish has picked up over 1 million cubic yards of debris.

The parish advises that separating debris into construction debris and vegetation debris will allow for quicker pickup. Further separation into household hazardous waste, empty white goods like washing machines, air conditioners and refrigerators, and

Louisiana Federal Credit Union donates school supplies to recovering classrooms

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In the wake of the severe damage suffered by schools from Hurricane Ida, Louisiana Federal Credit Union has provided affected classrooms with much-needed school supplies.

The credit union recently delivered pirogues filled with 10,126 school supply items to 12 classrooms in southeast Louisiana — including to teachers at St. Rose Elementary, Norco Elementary and Ethel Schoeffner Elementary.

“Teachers and students are experiencing enough burden as it is,” Rhonda Hotard, president and CEO of Louisiana FCU, said. “This is one small way to help alleviate the financial pressure.”

LFCU Director of Business Development and Community Outreach Kim Bourgeois said the recipients were nominated by community members during the credit union’s annual Pack the Pirogue supplies drive.

“This is an event we do annually, but this year it was so timely with so many classrooms losing so much,” Bourgeois said. “This is the most we’ve ever collected ... that was

phenomenal.”

Bourgeois said the credit union facilitated the drive through its Facebook page by putting out a call for donations and nominations for teachers. She said Pack the Pirogue garnered 120 nominations and attracted thousands of physical and monetary donations from credit union staff, members and local businesses, such as ADM Grain and

St. Charles Parish Hospital has earned an ‘A’ Fall 2021 Hospital Safety Grade from The Leapfrog Group, a designation that recognizes efforts in protecting patients from harm and meeting the highest safety standards in the United States.

The Leapfrog Group, an independent national watchdog organization, assigns an “A,” “B,” “C,” “D,” or “F” grade to general hospitals across the country based on over 30 national performance measures reflecting errors, injuries, accidents and infections, as well as systems hospitals have in place to prevent harm.

“This Leapfrog ‘A’ rating can be attributed to the work ethic of our nurses, physicians and staff,” Keith

American Legion, Coast Guard spend Veteran’s Day repairing post 131

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American Legion Post 131 in Luling received substantial damage from Hurricane Ida, but the post’s roof was patched and a substantial amount of demo work was done recently when the U. S. Coast Guard Greater New Orleans Chief Petty Officers’ Association visited and volunteered.

Jessica Tull, an active-duty Coast Guard member and post 131’s finance and fundraising officer, said the work was done on the most-fitting of days – Veterans Day.

“Because the average age of our members is 70 years old, we don’t have the in-house labor to do the repairs ourselves,” Tull said. “We need our building back up and running to

on, even after his life was tragically cut short on Nov. 9, when the 30-year-old New Sarpy man died of heart failure.

And recently, it was Calhoun’s on-screen mother who was among those answering a call for help by Calhoun’s real-life mother, Theresa Bailey, who created a GoFundMe page to raise funds for a proper funeral for her son. The family did not have life insurance for Calhoun.

“I know this is a trying time for everyone, however I am inclined to ask for your help because my son is in need of his community’s support,” posted Bailey to the fundraiser page. “Coronji Calhoun Sr. recently joined the ancestors in watching over me and our family on October 13, 2021 ... Unfortunately, we did not have any life insurance policy on him (as we never expected this tragedy

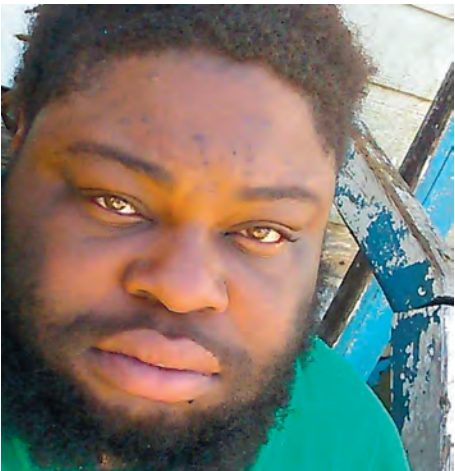
to befall us) before he transitioned. Now we ask for generosity in your donations as we prepare to give Coronji a sacred celebration of life.”

Berry, as well as Monster’s Ball producer Lee Daniels, each donated sums of \$3,394, helping to spur the fundraiser over the family’s goal of \$10,000.

“On behalf of the Calhoun and Bailey family, I would like to thank each and every individual who found it in their hearts to extend the much-needed financial support to lay Coronji Sr. to rest,” Bailey wrote in an update post on the fundraiser page. “We are blown away by the outpouring of love the community and Coronji’s adopted family has shown during our process of grief.

“While the financial burden has been lifted, we still mourn the loss of my son. As we close this chapter, we ask that in your remembrance of him, you remember to love your neighbor as yourself, because that is what Coronji did for his entire community.”

Calhoun played the role of Tyrell in Monster’s Ball, the son of Leticia (Berry) and Lawrence (Combs) Musgrove. The movie tells the story of a corrections officer who begins a relationship with a woman, unaware that she is the widow of a man he assisted in executing. The film was a hit, grossing nearly \$45 million worldwide and earned numerous

accolades. The movie was also filmed in New Orleans, making it a natural fit for Calhoun.

Berry’s role is the one she is perhaps best known for. Her portrayal of Leticia Musgrove earned her an Academy Award for best actress in a leading role, the first and only black actress to date to have done so.

In the film, Tyrell is portrayed as artistically gifted, but a victim of abuse. The character dies in the film after being struck by a car, a tragedy that sets the film’s major events in motion.

Calhoun leaves behind a son, 10, and stepson, 13.

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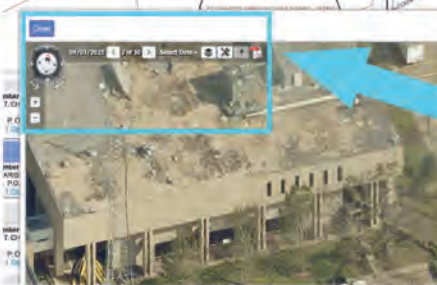

which the couple rode out the storm at the home of Ward’s parents in St. Rose. The storm took the roof completely off the house and its insulation and ceiling caved in – and worse, the family was underinsured, leaving a great many questions and precious few answers.

But fast forward several weeks and Ward feels nothing short of incredibly blessed.

A plea for help on social media in the immediate aftermath of the storm rallied more support than she ever dreamed of. Thanks to several donations, some from friends, others from perfect strangers, the Wards’ home now has a new roof and concrete floors, and it sounds like it won’t be too long before the family can move back in.

“I was hoping to be back in by Christmas, but that probably won’t happen. It can’t hurt to dream though,” Ward said. “But we’re working with a local contractor we know very well and he’s taking care of us in every way.”

For Ward, who just recently gave birth to the couple’s second child, a cold feeling of hopelessness has been replaced with incredible warmth.

“There will never be enough words or enough time to show how grateful we are,” she said. “So many people got behind us during the hardest time of my entire life, and I know my husband would say the same. This community really picked us up.

“There’s no place like St. Charles Parish, I can tell you that.”

Their home was considered a total loss following Ida and the couple lost just about all of their belongings, save for the few items they packed for what they expected to be a brief stay with Ward’s parents to take shelter.

“Thank God for them,” Ward said of her parents, whose home the Wards have been staying at after a two-week evacuation to Kentucky. “We didn’t even have to ask. My mom has been incredible helping with the new baby and helping me be able to get back to work. I’ve had, literally, the best support system.”

While the replacement roof and reestablishment of the family’s home might have made the biggest impact, it is far from the only gesture that made a significant difference for Ward.

“People gave us diapers, made us

home-cooked meals ... everyone just wanted to help and found a way to,” Ward said. “Sometimes, it was just \$5 for a cup of coffee, or just saying a prayer for us.

“I still remember walking out of my house feeling so hopeless at the beginning of all of this. The outpouring we received after I asked for help is absolutely unbelievable.”

The roof, she says, will always be a reminder.

“When I lay my head down at night, once we’re finally back in, that roof will be sheltering us and all of the community helped to put it there in such a dire time,” she said.

electronics like computers and televisions will also help expedite the process.

Residents are reminded that debris should be put curbside but should not block the roadway, drains, culverts or ditches.

Additionally, residents are asked to not put debris near or on other trees, utility poles, fire hydrants or other structures like gas or water meters.

At a recent joint press conference with St. Charles and St. John Parish government officials and FEMA, it was

noted that approximately 80 percent of storm debris had been removed.

Approximately a week after Hurricane Ida, DRC Emergency Services began collecting debris.

Residents are asked to limit curbside garbage to two 32-gallon containers or eight trash bags, share piles with neighbors and secure refrigerator and freezer doors with duct tape.

Hurricane Ida's estimated damage tally of \$95 billion would make it the seventh costliest hurricane to hit the U.S. since 2000, according to AccuWeather.

"We always enjoy supporting the community that we serve," Bourgeois said. "It's one of our core values, but this year had a more meaningful impact."

Mary-Lynn Detillier, an Ethel Schoeffner Elementary teacher and pirogue recipient, said she was extremely

grateful to receive supplies.

"You need certain things to help you succeed in the classroom," she said. "Teachers spend a lot of our hardworking money on supplies for our kids, because not all of them come with the supplies needed. It's really amazing that Louisiana Federal Credit Union put this on and blessed all of these teachers this year."

be able to rent it out ... and most importantly to hold our meetings our sweet veterans look forward to each month."

Tull said the collaboration with the Petty Officers' Association will continue, as the association has offered to accept donations on the post's behalf.

"The roof definitely has to be repaired," Tull said, adding there was extensive structural damage to the post's building. "It'll be an easy \$50,000 to \$60,000 worth of work."

Tull said what the post needs most is volunteers and skilled professionals to point post members in the right direction to get started on repairs.

“We only had liability insurance due to the loss of income over the last couple years due to COVID,” she said. “We are setting up an account for donations at First American Bank in Boutte to assist in paying for materials to rebuild.”

Tull said the work completed on Veterans Day was a bright spot during a dark time for many of the post's elderly members.

"It just really means a lot to the members to know that this post is going to survive," she said. "It kind of gave them hope. I wouldn't have wanted to spend Veterans Day at any other place ... it brought hope."



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Destrehan hosts dangerous Woodlawn

Panthers felled Division I top seed earlier this season, led by Purdue committed QB

Following Destrehan's dominant first round victory over visiting West Jefferson, the No. 4 seeded Wildcats prepare to host a Woodlawn of Baton Rouge team led by a premier passer, huge offensive line and talented secondary.

The winner of this game will advance to the quarterfinals to face the winner of No. 5 Ruston and No. 12 Benton.

As the No. 13 seed and preparing to hit the road, Woodlawn enters this one as an underdog, but it has already proven a dangerous foe in that role.

The Panthers (5-4) advanced to round two with a decisive 42-14 win over Natchitoches Central. But three weeks ago, it proved it can stand toe-to-toe

with the best as it upset a then top-ranked Catholic-Baton Rouge (and current No. 1 seed in Division I) 35-28, in a game that went down to the wire.

"They did a really good job preparing for that game," said Destrehan head coach Marcus Scott. "It was back-and-forth and they made a couple more plays than Catholic that night in a very exciting game and big win for them."

Quarterback Rickie Collins scored the game-winning touchdown on a 1-yard run in that one, on a night where he completed 14-of-20 passes for 198 yards and a touchdown. Collins, a junior, is committed to play at Purdue University and has been rated as a four-star recruit.

"He makes it all go," said Scott. "He has three receivers he can go to who are all threats, guys who can make plays after the catch."

But the night's star was running back Amari Givens, who tallied 161 yards and three touchdowns to pace the Panthers, who handed Catholic its lone loss of the season. The powerful rusher is averaging close to eight yards per carry on the season and figures to draw a ton of attention from a stout Destrehan run defense.

"(Givens) is their primary guy, and then (Jayveon Hayes) also comes in and he's a good runner as well. They run behind a huge offensive line and they execute well. We'll have our hands full," Scott said.

The receivers Scott alluded to include Kyle Jones, Jaylon Henry and Clayton Adams.

Woodlawn did not play a full 2020 campaign, losing all but four regular season

games on its schedule due to the pandemic and finishing the season 2-3 overall. Assuredly eager to get back on the field in 2021, it was nonetheless a slow start for the Panthers, who began the season with three losses in four weeks. Things began to turn around in a 27-14 win over Dutchtown. A 48-41 win over St. Amant followed before the Panthers absorbed their fourth loss of the season in a 26-20 loss to East Ascension.

Then came the Catholic win, and then a 62-0 route of McKinley to close the regular season on the upswing.

Defensively, Scott said Catholic poses a challenge up front and on the back end alike, with athleticism across the line and in the secondary, where Marcus Stewart, Dezaray Delmore and Jordan Matthews comprise one of the team's strongest units. Matthews, a four-star defensive back, has been offered by LSU, Arkansas and California, among many. At 6'2 and 175 pounds, he is a prototype and figures to see plenty of Destrehan

top targets Calvin Bullock and Daniel Blood – possibly with time on both, though his size could make him the natural pick to cover the 6'4 Bullock.

But it is Collins that makes this a truly dangerous opponent. Hotly recruited by LSU among many others prior to his Purdue commitment, the 6'3 dual threat puts Woodlawn opponents in a bind. His sophomore season, despite just a five-game sample, saw him total 1,449 yards of offense to go with 16 total touchdowns.

Destrehan got off to a slow start in its last game of the regular season – it was tied 0-0 at halftime of an eventual 31-0 victory at Thibodaux. So, all week, the Wildcats put extra emphasis on starting strong in its round one Class 5A playoff opener against visiting West Jefferson.

The fourth-seeded Wildcats accomplished that directive – leaping out to a 21-0 first quarter lead on the way to an eventual 48-14 victory and ticket to round two.

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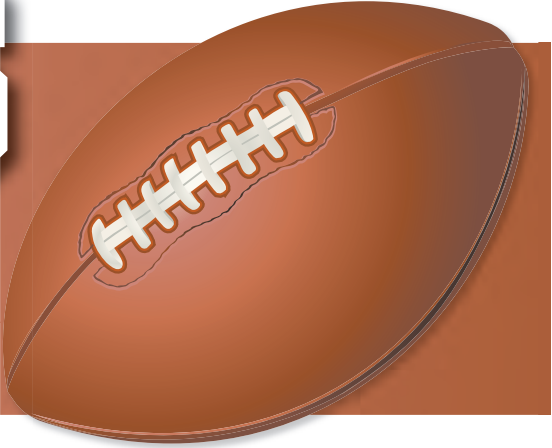

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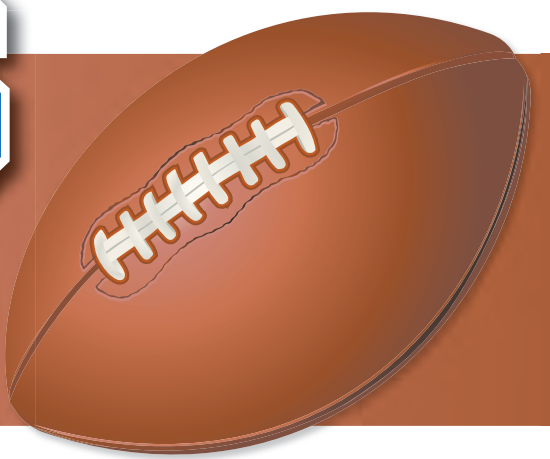

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Benton special teams keys playoff win over HHS

Tigers had won 5 straight entering Round 1

It wasn't at all what Hahnville envisioned. The Tigers' five-game winning streak came to an end Friday night – and with it, their season – as No. 12 Benton won a 38-31 shootout at home over the No. 21 seeded Tigers.

Benton recovered two onside kicks during the game and returned two kick-offs for touchdowns – including the eventual game-winner, one that came on the kickoff following a game-tying touchdown and successful two-point conversion by Hahnville. “It was a tale of four plays,” said a disappointed Hahnville head coach Daniel Luquet, as he and his team returned home from Shreveport. Just over a week ago, that trip was not one Hahnville expected to make. The Tigers were eager to wrap up the regular season with a win and then learn who they would be hosting in the play-offs – a home date it had earned and one that promised to carry a great emotional atmosphere with it in the wake of Hurricane Ida. As its community rebuilt, the Tigers in kind rebuilt their season after an 0-2 start. But the LHSAA announcement last week that De La Salle would have to forfeit multiple wins affected each of the team's the Cavaliers had faced, Hahnville among them – the Tigers earned a 14-13

win over a De La Salle team that would go on to be 5-2 before forfeiting four wins. The impact to Hahnville's power ranking was significant – the team dropped 10 spots and were set for a road trip. “These guys haven't had anything go our way all year,” Luquet said. “The storm, then we fight our tail off to win five games and get a home playoff game, then the forfeits and we have to go on the road to face a team like this in the playoffs. That's a well-coached team and they executed their gameplan. “But, still, we shouldn't be getting on a bus for a six-hour ride home. That's for sure.” Hahnville raced out to a 14-0 lead early in the game, with Donovan Friloux connecting with Titus White for the first score and then a returning from injury K'Jon Smith punching in the night's second touchdown from 10-yards out. That start included a defensive stop by Hahnville on Benton's first drive, holding firm after the latter executed and recovered an onside kick to start the game. But after Smith's score, Benton's Pearce Russell took the ensuing kickoff 98 yards for a touchdown to cut the lead in half. “We missed a couple of tackles, jumped out of our lane ... things we haven't done all year on special teams,” Luquet said. “We talk about wrong shouldering ... you do it against a team you overmatch, you can get away with it. You do it in the playoffs, that team is gonna capitalize.” That was the start of a seesaw, back and forth game that saw Benton tie things up, Hahnville take a 20-14 lead on a Cincere Simmons touchdown run and Benton jump back ahead 21-20 at halftime.

Benton carved out a 31-20 lead before Hahnville fought back to tie. Tate White converted a field goal to cut the lead to eight, then HHS tied the game on a Friloux touchdown run and two-point conversion. But Benton snatched the lead back immediately on its second kickoff return for a score of the night, which proved the winning points. Friloux finished the game with 70 yards on 20 carries, while completing 14-of-22 pass attempts for 131 yards and one touchdown. Cincere Simmons, known for his dominating play on the defensive line, played two ways and led the offensive backfield with 12 carries for 86 yards and a touchdown. Troy Kendrick caught 10 passes for 64 yards. Joshua Joseph totaled 95 yards and a touchdown, a 58-yard receiving score. It was a season the Tigers hoped would extend much further, as a dominating defense was meshing with a maturing offense as the team entered the postseason.

But the loss notwithstanding, Luquet said he was proud of a group that battled through adversity on and off the field, starting this season with Hurricane Ida, and a senior class that's gone through even more. In 2018, the current senior class went through a season impaired by the ruling that quarterback Andrew Robison was ineligible. In 2019, it was a season ended when an apparent playoff game-winning kick was negated by penalty at Zachary. In 2020, COVID-19. “I'm not sure these seniors have had a normal year since they've been here,” said Luquet. “Everything they've gone through ... our leaders really stepped forward this year and showed the character they have. Some teams, with lesser leadership, would have folded at 0-2. These are resilient guys. “I told them I loved ‘em and that I was proud of them. It hurts. It's gonna hurt. Sampey competed in Pomona, California over the weekend for the Auto Club NHRA Finals and, with it, a fourth World Championship. While she came up just short to eventual champion Matt Smith, Sampey earned her 44th and 45th career victories to get to that point, setting up a chance to win her first championship since 2002. Sampey won each of her three world crowns in consecutive years, from 2000 to 2002: her last world championship win was nearly 20 years ago, and a retirement ago, at that. Sampey left the sport behind in 2008 after a wildly successful 14-year run, seemingly closing the book on a dream that began in her teen years, when she would race dirt bikes with her brother. “I had no intention of ever returning,” Sampey said. “I was married, we had a little girl, life at home was all I ever dreamed it would be.” Six years later, she got a phone call and with it a request to make a return to fill in for a driver for her former team. That was supposed to be a temporary return. It was not. Sampey's competitive instincts were back in high gear. But her results weren't - not immediately. Excited at the prospect of her two daughters being able to see their mother speed to victory after victory, instead she found something of a struggle. “I felt guilty, because so much of it was how I wanted them to see it,” Sampey said. “I knew before they'd be able to watch videos or read articles, but I wanted them to see me do it and to see they could do anything they want to do in life. ‘Look how awesome – Mom wins races.’ But I struggled and struggled and struggled.” She admits it got to her. “I felt like a failure,” she said. But this season, things really started to click.

First, Sampey got her weapon of choice back. After riding a Harley Davidson for some time after her comeback, Harley withdrew from the sport entirely and ceased sponsoring. Her team switched to Suzuki – Sampey, incidentally, won all three of her world championships riding a Suzuki. “It felt strange at first. I hadn't rode a Suzuki since 2007,” Sampey said. “It didn't take long to get the hang of it again.” She began finding success again and toward the end of this season, for the first time in many years – she began to feel like she could not only compete with the best, but that she could once again be the best. “This was the first year I thought I was capable (of winning a championship) again,” she said. “I had my confidence back.” Her earlier struggles since returning are now something she calls a blessing. “That my daughters watched me struggle and struggle and not quit, keep working and pushing and then starting to win again, I think it's better that way,” Sampey said. “It happened the way it needed to.”

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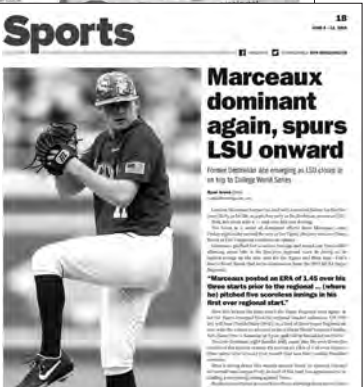
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
