



#### ARTICLE 1

#### STATEMENT OF WORK

- Contractor shall furnish all labor and materials and perform all of the work required to 1.01 build, construct and complete in a thorough and workmanlike manner.
- The abovementioned work shall be completed in strict accordance with Contract 1.02 Documents prepared by: McKim & Creed, Inc.
- 1.03 It is recognized by the parties herein that said Contract Documents including by way of example and not of limitation, the Drawings and Specifications dated October 2022, Addenda number(s) 1, the Instruction to Bidders, Supplemental Instructions to Bidders, Louisiana Uniform Public Works Bid Form, General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions (if applicable), any Addenda thereto, impose duties and obligations upon the parties herein, and said parties thereby agree that they shall be bound by said duties and obligations. For these purposes, all of the provisions contained in the aforementioned Contract Documents are incorporated herein by reference with the same force and effect as though said Contract Documents were herein set out in full.

The Work for the East Bank "C" Plant Filter Upgrade, Parish Project No. WWKS-96, is generally comprised but necessarily limited to, the removal, disposal, and replacement of the "C" Plant washtroughs and associated hardware, filter media, siphons, vacuum pumps, piping from the vacuum tank to the inlet and backwash siphons, 6" water supply piping, surface sweep rotating bearings, and effluent weir and guide channels. It also includes the removal, disposal, and replacement of the operating and access platforms (to include handrails and kickplates), as well as well as the filter floor system, which will be replaced with the Monoflor 1200 HD System. Other work includes pressure washing and roll painting the inside of the "C" Plant Filter building, removal/replacement of various

# ARTICLE 3

#### CONTRACT TIME

The Contractor shall complete all of the Work under the Contract within 240 calendar 3.01 days from the date stated in the Notice to Proceed.

#### ARTICLE 4

#### LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

4.01 Owner and Contractor recognize that the Owner will suffer direct financial loss if Work is not completed within the Contract Time specified plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with these General Conditions of this Contract, and therefore, time is of the essence. They also recognize the delays, expense and difficulties involved in proving in a legal preceding the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Contractor and Surety agree to forfeit and pay Owner Seven Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$750 per day) as Liquidated Damages for delay (but not as a penalty). 



# ENGINEER
